At this point we have collected all the articles and conducted an editing process with all the writers. We have also summarized the book as one complete and finished product. The book was submitted to Yediot Aharonot for review and right now we are progressing toward signing a contract with them for its publication.

The main achievements during the last year of activity (main achievements, number of events, number of participants, etc.):

Happily, we managed to bring together a very talented group of writers, Arabs and Jews with descriptions that take into account two important perspectives of friendly Jewish-Muslim relations: the connection between Judaism and Islam – including the issue of Arabic as a Jewish language, Islam in the Beit Midrash, and the role of religion (Judaism and Islam) in protecting the rights of the minority.

The other angle addresses the connection between the personal and the political, describing the different configurations of opportunities for connecting Jews and Muslims without sliding over the many challenges inherent in this task. As mentioned, the book contains 11 articles composed by 15 different Jewish and Arab writers. In addition, the book contains the speech given by King Hassan V to the American Jewish community as well as prefaces by the editors.

The evaluation (methodology, results, comparisons with the precedent year, conclusions for the future...):

This is the first book of its kind in which leading Jewish and Muslim figures in Israeli society address Jewish-Islamic heritage. We estimate that the issues raised will inspire others and we anticipate public debate on this clearly essential topic in Israeli society.
